Minutes

Director Mahaffy made a motion to approve the Regular Meeting minutes from February 27, 2024, which was seconded by Director Carmack. All Directors voted in favor of this motion.

Canteen for First Responders President, Dan Cunningham presented the February Canteen Report. There were 24 responses in February and 4 of them were in Florissant Valley, which is the most ever in one month. Dan also reminded the Board of the breakfast fundraiser on 4/5/2024 to benefit the Canteen.

The Board of Directors expressed their thanks for the opportunity to attend the MAFC Conference last week in Branson, MO. The Board also congratulated Chief Hoevelmann on his newly elected position as Vice President with the Missouri Association of Fire Chiefs.

Directors Report

The Treasurer's Report for March 5, 2024 was presented. The General fund expenses of \$36,563.17; the Ambulance fund expenses of \$4,287.77; the Capital Improvement fund expenses of \$521.05; the Payroll expenses of \$388,680.35; the Pension fund expenses of \$140,682.85; the Debt Service fund expenses of \$2,268,469.44; and the Vision fund expenses of \$960.08. There were no expenses Dispatch or Debt Service. There was a motion made by Director Carmack, which was seconded by Director Mahaffy, to approve the bills and transfer the necessary funds for the operation of the Fire District. All Directors voted in favor of this motion.
