The Treasurer’s Report for March 12, 2024 was presented. The General fund expenses of \$22,140.93; the Ambulance fund expenses of \$10,433.90; the Capital Improvement fund expenses of \$8,229.33; and the Vision fund expenses of \$397.03. There were no expenses Pension, Payroll, Retiree Medical, Dispatch or Debt Service. There was a motion made by Director Carmack, which was seconded by Director Mahaffy, to approve the bills and transfer the necessary funds for the operation of the Fire District. All Directors voted in favor of this motion.

Unfinished Business

Fire Marshal Robinson provided an update on the inspection that took place within the District on a commercial property that was out of compliance. Thanks to Battalion Chief Rob Carroll, Fire Inspector Steve Tuley, Firefighters Bobby Gray and Kyle Bennett for their assistance inspecting 108 rooms with 102 violations of fire codes. The commercial business has lost the occupancy permit until a structural evaluation is complete. The owners are cooperating and have 30 days to show compliance.

There was a discussion regarding the used radios that were purchased from Community FPD. They have been received, inventoried and need numbers assigned to them. At this time, the radios are not in service.

Fire Marshal Robinson provided an update on the renovation RFP at House 3. A walk through has been completed and bids will be opened at the BOD meeting on March 19, however, no decision will be made at the meeting. It has been written that the District has 60 days to determine the best option.
