The Treasurer's Report for April 14, 2026 was presented. The General fund expenses of \$16,623.30; the Ambulance fund expenses of \$46,047.94; the Payroll expenses of \$486,463.72; the Capital Improvement expenses of \$236,622.79; and the Vison fund expenses of \$1,788.63. There were no expenses for Pension, Retiree Medical, Debt Service or Dispatch. There was a motion made by Director Carmack, which was seconded by Director Mahaffy, to approve the bills and transfer the necessary funds for the operation of the Fire District. All Directors voted in favor of this motion.

The Board thanked Chief Hoevelmann for his leadership, staff and members for their continued hard work in the District and the pinning ceremony was a direct reflection of their dedication to the community.
