### Minutes

Director Mahaffy made a motion to approve the Regular and Executive Meeting minutes from April 9, 2024, which was seconded by Director Carmack. All Directors voted in favor of this motion.

### Directors Report

The Treasurer's Report for April 23, 2024 was presented. The General fund expenses of \$35,085.99; the Ambulance fund expenses of \$18,531.94; the Capital Improvement fund expenses of \$8,719.41; the Payroll expenses of \$402,738.55; and the Vision fund expenses of \$1,374.88. There were no expenses for Pension, Dispatch, Retiree Medical or Debt Service. There was a motion made by Director Carmack, which was seconded by Director Mahaffy, to approve the bills and transfer the necessary funds for the operation of the Fire District. All Directors voted in favor of this motion.

Chief Hoevelmann stated that the lettering on the vehicle has been removed thanks to Connor Buchheit and Frank Franer. Chief Hoevelmann requested that the vehicle be declared surplus property in an effort to list for sale on Govdeals. Director Carmack made a motion, which was seconded by Director Mahaffy to declare the old Unit 4005 to be declared a surplus vehicle for the purpose of sale in a public forum. All Directors voted in favor of this motion.

Chief Hoevelmann reminded the Board of the following events: Fire Up St. Louis will take place at House 1 and Mann's Meats is celebrating their 5<sup>th</sup> anniversary at the VFW hall, profits will be donated to the Canteen for First Responders. Also, there was a discussion regarding the Valley of Flowers event coming up the following weekend.

Chief Hoevelmann stated that the truck committee spoke with apparatus distributors who informed them that the build time for a new truck is now 3 plus years out from delivery. Chief Hoevelmann reminded the Board that the oldest frontline truck is 2016. A discussion took place.

With no further business to come before the Board, there was a motion made by Director Carmack, which was seconded by Director Mahaffy, to adjourn this meeting. All Directors voted in favor of this motion. The meeting was adjourned at approximately 7:43 a.m.
