Chief Hoevelmann reported the following:

Directors Report

Director Carmack made a motion, which was seconded by Director Mahaffy to apply for this grant and have Chief Hoevelmann sign the MOU Agreement. All Directors voted in favor of this motion.

A motion was made by Director Carmack, which was seconded by Director Mahaffy that in accordance with RsMo. 610.021 (1), (3), (9), (11), & (13) that the Board would go into executive session to discuss legal and personnel matters. All Directors voted in favor of this motion.
