Minutes

Director Mahaffy made a motion to approve the Regular meeting minutes from June 9, 2026 which was seconded by Director Carmack. All Directors voted in favor of this motion.

Directors Report

The Treasurer's Report for June 16, 2026 was presented. The General fund expenses of \$10,659.57; the Ambulance fund expenses of \$33,689.94; the Capital Improvement expenses of \$10,360.27; the Dispatch fund expenses of \$215,743.79; and the Vision expenses of \$861.65. There were no expenses for Payroll, Pension, Retiree Medical, or Debt Service. There was a motion made by Director Carmack, which was seconded by Director Mahaffy, to approve the bills and transfer the necessary funds for the operation of the Fire District. All Directors voted in favor of this motion.

Shop Steward Freihoff reminded the board of the Mayors golf tournament taking place on Friday.

Accountant Report

Accountant Rick Rognan proposed the 2025 amended budget. Director Carmack made a motion, which was seconded by Director Mahaffy to accept and approve the 2025 amended budget as written. All Directors voted in favor of this motion.

Account Rick Rognan proposed the 2025 Reserves appropriation from the general fund balance assigning \$8,000,000 for future appropriations; assigning \$6,000,000 for supplemental pension benefits; assigning \$6,000,000 for the purpose of GASB 45 Post-retirement benefits; and assigning \$2,000,000 for emergency preparedness. Director Mahaffy made a motion, which was seconded by Director Carmack to approve the proposed appropriations for the 2025 Budget. All Directors voted in favor of this motion.

Accountant Rick Rognan presented the May 2026 Financial Report.

Unfinished Business

New Business

Chief Hoevelmann stated that he is meeting with all three shifts this week regarding the 2026 Budget and proposed pension changes including contributions made by the District and cost of living increases. Chief Hoevelmann stated that he remains focused on conservative long-term fiscal responsibility for the District.

A motion was made by Director Mahaffy, which was seconded by Director Carmack that in accordance with RSMo 610.021 (1), (3), (9), (11) and (13) that the Board would amend the Board Meeting Agenda and go into closed Executive session to discuss legal and personnel matters. All Directors voted in favor of this motion.

With no further business coming before the Board, there was a motion made by Director Lubiewski, which was seconded by Director Mahaffy, to adjourn this meeting. All Directors voted in favor of this motion. The meeting was adjourned at approximately 8:05 a.m.
