Department Reports

Chief Hoevelmann presented the Run Report for the week of June 22 - June 28, 2025. There were a total of 100 Fire and EMS calls and 245 Ambulance calls

Canteen President, Danny Cunningham presented the Canteen Report for June 2025. The Canteen volunteers have responded to 19 incidents totaling more than 36 days of volunteer hours to date this year. Danny also advised that the Monarch Fire Protection District has agreed to house a Canteen vehicle at one of their houses to better serve the First Responders in West County.

Directors Report

The Treasurer's Report for July 1, 2025 was presented. The General fund expenses of \$162,803.27; the Ambulance fund expenses of \$6,926.57; the Capital Improvement fund expenses of \$2,616.73; the Pension expenses of \$148,923.29; the Payroll expenses of \$117,932.73; and the Vision fund expenses of \$2,299.22. There were no expenses for Dispatch, Retiree Medical or Debt Service.
