The Treasurer's Report for August 4, 2026, was presented. The General fund expenses of \$27,087.88; the Ambulance fund expenses of \$17,418.12; the Pension fund expenses of \$183,482.46; the Retiree Medical fund expenses of \$1,766.79; the Vision fund expenses of \$678.00; and the Capital Improvement fund expenses of \$32,615.91. There were no expenses for Payroll, Dispatch or Debt Service. There was a motion made by Director Carmack, which was seconded by Director Mahaffy, to approve the bills and transfer the necessary funds for the operation of the Fire District. All Directors voted in favor of this motion.

New Business

The Board led a discussion regarding a call yesterday for a trench collapse that 4026 Heavy Rescue truck was dispatched out of the FVFPD service area.

Chief Hoevelmann advised that he attended the Wednesday night out event and it was well attended, receiving many compliments and wishes for FVFPD staff and members.

Chief McHugh stated that the tour of House 1 from Hazelwood Board of Directors went well and was able to provide knowledge to the members who had questions in design and implementation of construction of firehouses.

With no further business to come before the Board, there was a motion made by Director Carmack, which was seconded by Director Mahaffy, to adjourn this meeting. All Directors voted in favor of this motion. The meeting was adjourned at approximately 7:44 a.m.
