Minutes

Directors Report

The Treasurer's Report for August 18, 2026, was presented. The General fund expenses of \$168,120.34; the Ambulance fund expenses of \$24,943.42; the Retiree Medical Trust fund expenses of \$2,597.84; and the Vision fund expenses of \$6,265.83. There were no expenses for Payroll, Pension, Capital Improvement, Dispatch or Debt Service. There was a motion made by Director Carmack, which was seconded by Director Mahaffy, to approve the bills and transfer the necessary funds for the operation of the Fire District. All Directors voted in favor of this motion.

Shop Steward Freihoff reported that the shop is busy preparing for the FVFPD Golf tournament on September 11th, 2026.

Attorney's Report

Attorney Dan Bruntrager reported that he is working on the AI Policy along with the IAFF in Washington DC to help facilitate adopting a policy for all Local 2665 Fire Districts to approve. A discussion took place.

Unfinished Business

Chief Hoevelmann advised that he has a meeting with representatives from the Florissant Historical Society regarding the 101-year-old house at 121 Rue St. Francois and the plans to take it down for the purpose of expansion at House 1. A discussion took place.

New Business

Chief Hoevelmann requested the board approve a Request for Proposal for extrication tools for 4026 Heavy Rescue truck with bid openings taking place at the board meeting scheduled for September 22nd. Chief Hoevelmann will work with the district attorney to prepare the language. Director Mahaffy made a motion, which was seconded by Director Carmack to approve the RFP process for extrication tools for 4026. All Directors voted in favor of this motion.

Chief Hoevelmann stated that he is participating in the interview process for the Missouri State Fire Marshal and Lee's Summit Fire Chief Mike Snider was elected as 2nd Vice President to the Executive Board at IAFC.

With no further business to come before the Board, there was a motion made by Director Carmack, which was seconded by Director Mahaffy, to adjourn this meeting. All Directors voted in favor of this motion. The meeting was adjourned at approximately 8:02 a.m.
