### Minutes

Director Mahaffy made a motion to approve the Regular meeting minutes from August 12, 2025 which was seconded by Director Carmack. All Directors voted in favor of this motion.

All Directors voted in favor of this motion.

### Accountant's Report

Director Carmack made a motion, which was seconded by Director Lubiewski to declare the extra AED as surplus and approved the donation of the surplus AED to the Canteen. All Directors voted in favor of this motion.
